# Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy for Impact Estate ("We", "Us" or "Our") explains how we collect, use, and share your information when you visit our website <https://impact-estate.com/>. We encourage you to read this document carefully before using the website. By using the website, you are accepting and consenting to the practices described in this Privacy Policy.

## 1. What Information Do We Collect About You?

When we collect information, we do so to ensure that you get to experience our service seamlessly. We collect the following personal information about you:

- Name
- Address
- Email address
- Location data
- Professional or employment-related information

## 2. How Do We Collect Such Information?

We may use any of the following three ways to obtain information about you:

### a. The information that you give us

### b. The information that we automatically collect from you

### c. Information that we collect from third parties

These third parties can be data aggregators, online directories, data marketplaces or exchanges, from where we may collect information about you.

## 3. Cookies and Similar Technologies

Cookies are small packets of information placed on your device so that we can retrieve information about you, such as your login information, your choices on our websites, and other information. ### Do Not Track Requests

## 4. Why Do We Collect Information About You?

We collect information about you for the following purposes:

- To perform a contract with us
- To provide and maintain our service
- To send marketing and promotional communications

## 5. How Long Do We Retain Your Information?

---

We will only keep your personal information for as long as it is necessary, unless a longer retention period is required or permitted by law (such as tax, accounting, or other legal requirements). No purpose in this notice requires us to retain your personal information for longer than the period during which users have an account with us.

When we have no ongoing legitimate business need to process your personal information, we will either delete or anonymise such information, or, if this is not possible (for example, because your personal information has been stored in backup archives), we will securely store your personal information and isolate it from any further processing until deletion is possible.

## 6. Do We Share Your Information?

We may share your information with third parties in the following ways:

- **Sharing with your consent:** When you give consent, we may share your information with third parties for the purposes mentioned in the consent notification.
- **Legal obligations:** We may disclose information where we are legally required to do so in order to comply with applicable law, governmental requests, a judicial proceeding, court order, or legal process.
- **Business transfers:** We may share your personal information in connection with merger, sale of business assets, financing, or acquisition of all or part of our business by another entity.

### Sale or Sharing of Information

We do not sell or share the information we collect from our users.

## 7. GDPR Disclosures

### Automatic Processing of Data

We do not use any automated processing of the personal information we collect.

### Legal Basis for the Collection

The General Data Protection Regulation requires us to identify the legal basis for processing your personal information. We process your personal data based on your **consent**: we may process your personal information for the purposes described in this Privacy Policy with your consent.

### Your Rights

In accordance with Articles 12 to 23 of the General Data Protection Regulation, you have the following rights:

- Right to object to the processing of personal data in certain circumstances.
- Right to request access to the data we have collected about you and to receive a copy in an accessible format.
- Right to restrict the processing of your personal data for a limited period, under certain circumstances.
- Right to rectify or modify personal information that you consider obsolete, incomplete, or inaccurate.

- Right to opt out of automated processing of your personal data.
- Right to erasure of your personal information (the right to be forgotten).

While we use commercially reasonable security measures, we cannot promise that your information will be 100% secure.
